WHAT TO EXPECT

Receive a tailored exercise and nutrition prescription addressing your individual needs. Plus gain access to health classes and educational material.

Be placed in 1 of 3 groups:

- Text messaging program on diet and physical activity, with weekly check-ins.
 - Group, exercise classes 2x/week and virtual nutrition classes
- 1-on-1 weekly meetings with an Exercise Physiologist and Registered Dietitian

Wear a Fitbit to track your activity, and use the MyWellnessResearch software platform to track your progress.



Are you eligible to participate in the OnPoint Study?

- Are you 18 years or older?
- Have you been diagnosed and treated with Breast, Prostate, or colorectal cancer?
- Are you able to speak, read and write in either English or Spanish?
- Are you interested in working to change your diet and activity levels in order to find out if these can improve your health?

To explore if a tailored intervention on diet and physical activity can improve adherence to the current recommendations and improve quality of life, physical function, nutrition and body composition.
