

# **Participant Intervention**






IVR = Interactive Voice Response ATSM = Automated Telephone System Management TIPC = Telephone Interpersonal Counseling



## **Progress**

- Protocol activation 5/20/24
- Opened to patient accrual 10/4/24
  - N= 247 patients enrolled (as of 11/18/2025)
    - Top enrolling site Aspirus CROWN
    - Special shout out to Lake Regional Ozarks, still highest enrolling single site with n=22!
- 15 sites enrolled
  - N=7 IVR "Control", N=8 ATSM "Intervention"
  - 11 of 12 Rural-qualified practices
  - N=53 nonpatients enrolled (as of 10/31/2025)



# Spanish Speakers Enrollment

- Target 15% Spanish Speakers (N=78)
  - 6 Practices have >10%+ Spanish Speakers (SS)
    - One site, Puerto Rico, has 99%.
  - 9 Practices have <10% Spanish Speakers</li>
- Enrollment to Date
  - YTD Total Spanish Speaking Enrollments: 34
  - YTD SS% of Total Enrollment: 14.2%



# Intervention/TIPC Updates

- Telephone Interpersonal Counselling
  - Only for clinics in ATSM/Intervention randomization arm
  - Delivered by behavioral health specialist, social worker, etc.
    - Site versus study-provided
  - Initiated in weeks 1-4, 8-week duration
  - Centralized calls through My Wellness Research® for monitoring and fidelity

- TIPC Referrals to Date
  - Anmed Upstate Carolina (n=1)
  - Carle (n=1)





- Months 1-25 "Actions Taken" are due for IVR Report Recipients
  - There is also a TIPC feasibility monthly report
- Months 1-25 Recruitment report: numbers of screened, eligible, approached; reasons for ineligibility or refusal; and any issues encountered with recruitment.

### Vital Status Reports in RAVE

- · Vital Status Reports in Rave
  - Calendar-based date is only an estimate
    - This date is set to a max of 10 days after registration, and the real date will depend on when baseline can be completed (potentially weeks later, dependent upon patients answering and having started the oral agent).
  - Weeks should align, even if dates don't.
    - The week 1 vital status should be completed when the first symptom report is received from Miami. Ideally, within 1 week of due date.
  - There is flexibility in the dates, up to 2 weeks is okay.
    - If > 2 weeks, contact <u>symon@miami.edu</u> to request for NRG to update the calendarbased date. Provide the following information:
      - » Subject #: CC012CD-00XXX
      - » Original Calendar Base Date: 6/30/2025
      - » Requested change to Calendar Base Date: 7/30/2025



### "Discontinuation of Medication"

This is a common reason reported by participants for not answering our calls. We leave voicemails but unless we speak to them, we won't know why they aren't answering. We are not able to text/email.

## Participant Study Completion

- You will receive an email from Jamillah when your participant has completed their Week 17 interview/final study activities. We also notify NRG.
- Usually we start trying to complete Week 17 around the same time as the IVR, but with preferred times/scheduling it may take 2-3 weeks to complete.




